1. All oranges purchased will meet the requirements of the Commodity Specification for Fresh Citrus August 2014 with the following exception: The grade of the purchased oranges will be U.S. Fancy. The grade will be determined at destination using the following U.S. Grade Standards:

For oranges originating from California or Arizona

- United States Standards for Grades of Oranges (California and Arizona)

For oranges originating from Florida

- United States Standards for Grades of Florida Orange and Tangelos

For oranges originating from Texas (and States other than Florida, California and Arizona)

- United States Standards for Grades of Oranges (Texas and States other than Florida, California and Arizona)

2. Only sizes 113 and larger will be accepted.

The above grade standards are attached to the amended solicitation.
