Q: One of our suppliers just want to verify that the cartons can be loose packed in a carton correct. Just need something to show them from you.

A. No, (110151) - APPLES FRESH VARIOUS TYPE CTN-37-40 LB are to be in tray packs.

Q: We have copies of the audits for both the orchard and packing facilities, see attached. However, we will not get copies of the certificates until a couple of weeks.

What do we do if the certificates are not here by the time we need to turn in bid 2000010311?

A. If a bidder has submitted supplier on their USDA GAP GHP verification form with passing GAP GHP scope(s), but certificates have not been issued yet, AMS may request additional documentation from that bidder to verify the supplier meets the intended requirements of the solicitation. The supplier must be listed on the USDA GAP GHP verification form, and have their audit passing audit(s) prior to the bid due date in order to be considered for the bid.

Q. What should a vendor do if they can't get an GAP or GHP Audit done in time to use their company or another supplier as a valid supplier on their bid and USDAGAP GHP verification form?

A. Suppliers who do not meet scopes for GAP or GHP prior to the bid due date may not be used in this solicitation and should not be listed on the USDA GAPGHP verification form. From the solicitation:

Vendors or subcontractors who are supplying fresh fruit crops to the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) must ensure that each of their suppliers/subcontractors who grow, harvest, pack, hold, and handle product have approved and current food safety verification audits PRIOR to the bid opening date of this solicitation. Good Agricultural Practices (GAP) and Good Handling Practices (GHP) scopes which are necessary to meet the minimum requirement to be deemed responsive are as follows:

GAP - Farm Review AND Field Harvesting & Field Packing Activities

GHP - House Packing Facility AND Storage & Transportation

Q.Are there any delay's in scheduling GAP or GHP audits out of the Michigan area?

A. Due to the volume of inspection and audit work requested in MI the audit scheduling process has taken longer than expected. Audits are being scheduled as soon as possible.

Q. If we are a new vendor bidding on multiple items, will WBSCM limit us to 10 awards automatically or would do we need to limit bids to 10 items under the probationary period.

A. For a new-to-USDA contractor and existing contractors who are bidding on new products, a probationary period may be implemented in which awards are limited to 10 truckloads per product. Contractor must demonstrate successful delivery of at least five (5) truckloads of product in order to be removed from probationary status on future solicitations. For the purposes of this rule, successful delivery is defined as product delivered on-time and in acceptable condition according to the terms and conditions of the contract. Any delivery problems directly attributable to the Government will not be held against the contractor. Please note this probationary period is per product.

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Q. WHY DOES THE USDA GAP GHP WEBSITE NOT SHOW ALL THE SCOPES? SHIPPERS HAVE BOTH GAP SCOPES AUDITED AND GHP SCOPES AUDITED BUT THEY DONT BOTH SHOW. ON SOME SHIPPERS THEY MAY JUST SHOW GHP AND NOT GAP OR VICE VERSA.

A. The USDA Website should be showing the audited scopes. If there is a scope missing from the website please have the shippers contact Audit Services Branch at SCAudits@usda.gov to inquire about this.
