Compared to last report: (10/21/24) Feeder lambs sold mostly 20.00-30.00 higher on all classes. Most lambs were purchased for slaughter again this sale. Slaughter lambs sold 25.00-30.00 higher on all weights. Demand for lambs was very good with several slaughter and feeder buyers in the stands actively bidding on offerings. Most feeder lambs were purchased to feed for ethnic slaughter. Most of these lambs were greener in flesh and needed some time on feed. Demand for slaughter lambs was mostly good to very good. Offerings were moderate. Hair lambs sold on very good demand. Quality was very attractive this sale. Most of these offerings were in ideal flesh for slaughter buyers and demand was very good as a result. Slaughter hair lambs sold 40.00-50.00 higher than last sales offering. Market activity was mostly active this sale with a large crowd on hand actively bidding on offerings. Demand for slaughter ewes was mostly moderate to good. Ethnic buyers showed good demand for fleshy or heavy utility ewes again this sale. Good slaughter ewes sold mostly steady to firm. High dressing, mostly black face ewes sold sharply higher driven mostly by ethnic demand. Utility and cull ewes sold steady to 5.00 higher. Slaughter kids sold mostly steady to 15.00 lower. Another very heavy offering of goats were seen this week. Feeder kids sold with the best demand this week as buyers continue to buy for the holiday and spring lull in supply. Feeder kids sold steady to 15.00 higher. Goat quality was mostly average to attractive this sale. Goat offerings were heavy. Supply included: 18% Feeder Sheep/Lambs (99% Lambs, 1% Hair Lambs); 43% Slaughter Sheep/Lambs (49% Wooled & Shorn, 8% Hair Breeds, 41% Ewes, 1% Hair Ewes, 1% Bucks); 0% Replacement Sheep/Lambs (100% Ewes); 10% Feeder Goats (100% Kids); 28% Slaughter Goats (85% Kids, 8% Nannies/Does, 1% Bucks/Billies, 1% Wethers, 5% Wether Kids); 0% Replacement Goats (100% Nannies/Does).
