Green City Livestock Market held their Annual Thanksgiving Special over the course of the holiday week, featuring yearlings on Tuesday and calves on Friday. No recent market test was available for the several loads and part loads that moved through the ring Tuesday but the undertone was higher. Quality was excellent and condition was about right on most of the cattle with the bulk of the offering coming from longtime reputation producers and backgrounders throughout the trade area. Buyers could best be described as "cautiously optimistic" with no new good or bad industry news the last few days. Early week, Live and Feeder Cattle futures had moved mostly sideways after massive sell offs the past couple weeks, creating a lot of volatility recently in the cash feeder trade but Tuesday's market found some footing and moved in the right direction. However, Friday's post-holiday trading session opened with sharp losses and only worsened as the day wore on, with nearby Live Cattle closing 4.22 to 4.35 lower and nearby Feeder contracts a dismal 7.22 to 7.80 lower.

After a bit of a slow start Friday morning as buyers watched the futures meltdown, the market took off as strings of reputation calves made their way into the ring, resulting in some larger than normal price spreads. Quality was, again, top notch and in many cases, quality and reputation trumped weaning status with several market tops set by strings of unweaned calves. Buyers are opting to assume the health risk, buy the optimism and shrug off the technicals. While we have taken a sizeable step back from the market highs of roughly four weeks ago, prior to the aforementioned volatility throughout the industry, it's worth noting that compared to a year ago, steer calves this year traded a full 65.00 to 80.00/cwt higher, yearling steers 50.00 to 60.00/cwt higher and all heifers consistently 55.00 to 65.00/cwt higher than the Thanksgiving Special in 2022. Supply moderate, demand good. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (61% Steers, 39% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 66%.
