Direct Hay Weighted Average Report for week ending 11/15/2024

Compared to the last report: Hay prices are mostly steady across all regions. Hay movement and demand are continuing to increase as warm season grasses are entering dormancy and cooler weather on the horizon. According to the Texas Crop Progress and Condition report, most parts of the state received anticipated rainfall over the past week. Rainfall ranged from trace amounts up to 10 inches, with the Southern Low Plains and the Cross Timbers receiving the most. Drought conditions ranged from none to exceptional drought with areas in the Trans-Pecos being the driest. Winter wheat is beginning to make a stand in the Panhandle with the last bit of moisture. In the Southern region, cooler weather has slowed down warm season forage growth so hay production has wrapped up. Producers are now prepping fields for row crop planting after the first of the year. The US Drought Monitor has reported that producers in the West are facing widespread drought with the exceptional drought category expanding to cover most or all of eastern Hudspeth, Culberson, western Reeves, Jeff Davis, Presidio, and Brewster Counties. Also, D3 (extreme drought) also expanded to cover most of the remainder of the Big Bend of Texas.

Due to limited sales and price changes this report will be released bi-weekly until more volumes of hay is moving.
