Direct Hay Weighted Average Report for week ending 11/22/2024

There will be no report the week of November 25th, 2024 due to the Thanksgiving Day holiday.

Producers are saying demand and movement are slow for this time of year. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, Southern and most of Eastern Idaho is abnormally to moderate dry soil moisture, Central Idaho is mostly under moderate dry soil moisture and Northern Idaho is under moderate to a little bit of severe soil moisture. The National Weather Service shows that precipitation is lower than normal for this time of year for all of Idaho, temperatures over the entire state have been higher than normal for this time of year. In Eastern Idaho average temperature was 51 degrees and precipitation was .58 inches. Southern and western Idaho average temperature was 56 degrees, average precipitation was .18 inches. Northern Idaho had average temperature of 45 degrees, average precipitation was .34 inches. According to the Idaho Crop Progress Report as of November 18th, 2024 pasture range is 28% good condition in Idaho. Idaho had cooler than normal temperatures this week with it freezing most nights. 95% of winter wheat has emerged in the state.


