Contacts in the East report there are few changes since last week's reporting. Milk output in the northeast is steadily increasing. Farmers are working to keep cows comfortable as temperatures fall and snow is forecast throughout the week. Temperatures ranging from the high-40s at night to the mid-60s for highs in the southeast have contributed to steady milk production. Florida weather runs warmer than the rest of the southeast with temperatures in the 70s. Plant downtime, due to the end-of-year holidays, is expected to interrupt regular operations and result in milk being more readily available going into the first weeks of 2025. Contacts say they will be trying to find homes for milk and cream in the coming weeks. Milk is available for all classes. Class I and Class III demand is steady to strong in the East. Cream remains abundant in the East. Demand from Class II and Class IV is steady. Class II production picked up slightly in recent weeks, and surplus cream found its way into churns. Condensed skim supplies are loose in the East, and demand remains light going into the holidays.
