Report for 7/1/2024 to 9/30/2024

13 producers participated in this report, representing farm sizes of: 101-200 acres (1 producer), 201-500 acres (5 producers), 501-800 acres (2 producers), >800 acres (5 producers). Participating producers estimated that the most common use for their sod was Landscape Contractors (52%) followed by Athletic Fields/Golf Courses (17%), Developers/Builders (9%), Retail/Garden Centers (10%), Homeowners (11%), and Other (2%). 62% of producers reported that their supplies were at least adequate for their current needs and 23% noted that their supplies were limited. 77% of participating producers plan to maintain their current production acres in the next year. 15% are planning on increasing production acres and 8% are decreasing. Prices in the report are Freight On Board (FOB). However, delivery charges vary by distance and are typically charged per square foot or per delivery. Reported delivery charges per square foot ranged from 6-10 cents/sq. ft. While charges per delivery ranged from 75-500 dollars. The third quarter showed good activity and demand. In the Northeast, sales for the season were moderate to good. New homes and construction helped sales. In the Midwest, sales were good. The wet weather made it difficult to manage the fields and in some cases loss of inventory was reported. In the South, Hurricane Helene made path through north Florida, Georgia, SW North Carolina, and Tennessee. Demand was slow and inventory was limiting. In the West, supply and demand were good. Quantity listed in units of 1000 square feet. Prices listed as cents per square foot. Prices are FOB. Regions are defined at the bottom of report.
