Compared to the last report, ammonium sulfate is up 16.33 a ton, MAP is up 2.94 a ton, Potash is down 0.67 a ton, urea is up 6.33 a ton. No. 2 Diesel fuel had small changes that increased and decreased but the average price remains steady, average propane prices increased by 0.19 a gallon.
