COLONY, HONEY PLANT AND MARKET CONDITIONS DURING NOVEMBER 2024

Effective January 2025, Colony, Honey Plant and Market Condition reports by state/district will no longer be included on this report. The updated report will instead include relevant data visualizations, including temperature and precipitation maps reflecting conditions in Honey Production Areas in the Continental United States.

APPALACHIAN DISTRICT (MD, PA, VA, WV): November began warmer than normal (upper 60's for daytime highs) and very dry. Some areas have not seen measurable rain in over a month. Due to the odd weather where it has been much warmer and drier than any year anyone can seem to remember, it is resulting in variable colony conditions and odd activity for this time of year. A couple even reported colonies were bringing in yellow pollen from camellias. By late November, the temperatures returned to more seasonable levels. A few are finding empty colonies where they have absconded or fell victim to robbing. Many continue to provide supplemental food. An occasional Beekeeper was looking to purchase new queens and continued to make sugar syrup and fondant for the upcoming winter. Beekeepers are generally concerned if colonies have made enough honey to survive the winter. A few beekeepers were taking preorders for spring nucs and others were selling their honey at holiday bazaars. Classes on winter colony management are being offered this month and private and public sponsored winter beekeeping classes have opened registration.

ALABAMA: Alabama experienced warm, dry weather for most of the month of November; this led to drought-like conditions in many locations. Some colder weather hit at the very end of the month, which likely resulted in the cessation of flowering of plants, such as goldenrod, and some asters, bidens, and salvia. In response to environmental conditions, capped brood in colonies declined, but still consisted of up to 2 frames. Beekeepers fed, or monitored their in-hive feed, throughout the month, especially because of a low nectar flow. Some beekeepers also treated for varroa, and consolidated weak colonies. Beekeepers made plans for winter varroa treatments, as well as storing and fixing equipment and supplies.

ARIZONA: The month of November 2024 showed slightly hotter than normal temperatures for this time of year. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor Arizona has remained in Moderate drought conditions throughout most of the state. The higher elevations of Northern Arizona still do provide some moisture and relief to these arid conditions.

This month was the 39th driest November on record (dating back to 1895). There was 0.32 inches of total precipitation for the month. This is a decrease of 0.53 inch from the average or normal.

The demand for honey remains good throughout most of the state. Desert bloom and cotton are among the main sources of pollen. Citrus is becoming more prevalent as a pollen source. To supplement feeding, some beekeepers have also resorted to using more concentrated pollen patties. Beekeepers continue to be optimistic heading into winter months.

ARKANSAS: During the month of November temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was below normal across most of the same area. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, the Eastern half of the state had normal soil moisture. The Western half of the state had abnormally dry to severe drought conditions. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

CALIFORNIA: No report issued.

FLORIDA: Temperatures were generally above average for the month with one cold week beginning around the middle of the month. This inhibited queen egg laying during that week. Precipitation statewide was below normal except for the western Panhandle and the Keys. Bee health was considered to be about average with mite control and issues with the queens being the biggest problems. Storm damage to trees and foliage earlier in the season combined with low precipitation resulted in few sources of food for the bees. Supplemental feeding was particularly heavy from the middle to the end of the month. Spanish Needle and parsley were two sources found mostly in areas of Central and South Florida. Hurricanes in September and October resulted in some loss of hives to flooding or wind, but the biggest loss may have been to sources of food such as Brazilian Pepper. Relief organizations mobilized to keep bees fed and prevent starving of hives. The Florida Association of Beekeepers was one of the many organizations who assisted beekeepers around the state. There was not much honey stored at the end of the month as very little honey has been produced in Florida since the first hurricane hit in early September. Most efforts since then have been directed at rebuilding hive numbers and health and just helping the hives to survive. Beekeepers are doing their best to recover and be ready for almond pollination season in California early next year. Those pollination fees are a very important source of income for many Florida beekeepers.

GEORGIA: No report issued.

IDAHO, COLORADO, UTAH: During the month of November temperatures were average in Idaho. Precipitation in Idaho was normal. Utah had temperatures that were average and precipitation that was normal. Colorado had average temperatures across the whole state, Precipitation for Colorado was above normal for November.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in November Southern Idaho had no drought to moderate drought and Northern Idaho had abnormally dry conditions to severe drought. Utah is currently under abnormally dry to moderate drought conditions. Colorado had normal soil moisture to extreme drought.

ILLINOIS: The weather for November has had warmer temperatures than usual, with less than average precipitation. Generally, the bees are in good condition. Beekeepers have treated for mites. No foliage remains. The bees are ready for winter. Demand for honey is pretty good at the retail level and only fair at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

INDIANA: The weather for November has been slightly cooler than average, and with a more than normal amount of rainfall. Beekeepers report their bees in good condition. Few beekeepers continued supplemental feeding of their bees. No foliage remains. The bees are ready for winter. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and demand was fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.

IOWA, KANSAS, MISSOURI, NEBRASKA: No report issued.

KENTUCKY: As colonies solidified their winter clusters, Kentucky beekeepers enjoyed abnormally warm weather during November 2024. The “Indian summer” had highs in the 60s-70sF in the first three weeks of November until it came to a bone-chilling stop on Nov.21, at which point temps plunged 30 degrees to settle into the average temperatures in November this time of year (30s-40s F). So, flowers were productive much longer in the season than normal with coneflowers, asters, and a few intrepid sunflowers were still blooming well past their normal bloom cycle. Beekeeping associations have been warning their members, beginners especially, to monitor the honey stores in their colonies, stressing that with such a long “fall” period, honeybees may have consumed more of their winter stores than the beekeepers had planned on. Beekeepers have been busy planning their winter activities and the forthcoming year’s events. Honey sales continue to remain strong in the state, pointing toward a productive season in 2025.

LOUISIANA: During the month of November temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was below normal across the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, mostly normal soil moisture covered the state. The Northeast and Southeast corners were under abnormally dry to moderate soil moisture. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

MICHIGAN: Much needed precipitation finally arrived in November in Michigan’s Upper Peninsula. The first half of the month still had unusually warm weather with more seasonal temps arriving towards the end of the first week of deer season. Not much going on in the bee yards as the hives are wrapped and hopefully ready for winter. Now it is time to start preparing for next spring, cleaning and fixing equipment and working on that next year’s wish list. Wildflower honey retails for \$9.00/pound.

MINNESOTA: During the month of November temperatures were average across the whole state. Precipitation for November was above normal for the North end of the state, the South end of the state had normal precipitation.

According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, in November, Northern Minnesota had abnormally dry conditions to severe drought and Southern Minnesota also had abnormally dry conditions to moderate drought.

MISSISSIPPI: No report issued.

MONTANA: No report issued.

NEW ENGLAND: No report issued.

NEW YORK: Except for the 3 northeast counties, all of NYS is dry, with the entire Hudson Valley to Long Island under moderate to severe drought conditions. There has been some precipitation with the commencement of the colder temperatures at the end of the month. Beekeepers continue to prep hives for winter (feeding, wrapping, use of Oxalic acid for varroa mite- including the newly approved extended release oxalic), and feel optimistic about the status of their hives. Honey sales very good.

NORTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

NORTH & SOUTH DAKOTA: No report issued.

OHIO: November rain fall was over 5 inches, soaking into the ground. A few areas received more, some areas received less. South Eastern Ohio still is in a drought. Have received rain, but need several inches to relieve the drought conditions. Ohio has had freezing temperatures, all natural nutrition is finished for 2024. Beekeepers who have Honey bee colonies that have commercial genetics are finding it difficult to control varroa, needing to use at least two different type of treatments more than once this year. Many colonies have absconded in the past several months.

Cold temperatures finally ceased flight of honey bee colonies in Ohio, with some snow in southeastern Ohio at the end of the month. Temperatures dropped mid month while rainfall covered most of the state. In the Cleveland area, 3 inches of rain fell, still less than the average 3.37”. Only an inch of snow fell, the last day of the month, unlike the average 4.5” for November. In southwestern Ohio, temperatures dropped to a low of 18 degrees F. Snow accumulation for the month totaled 2.6”. Rainfall totaled 4.76” which is above the average amount of 3.23 inches.

Beekeepers have mostly ceased mite control treatment for the year and followed multiple recommendations for winterizing colonies

OKLAHOMA: During the month of November temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation was well above normal across the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, conditions showed mostly normal soil moisture across most of the state. An area along the Southern border showed abnormally dry to severe conditions. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

OREGON: No report issued.

SOUTH CAROLINA: No report issued.

TENNESSEE: November nectar and pollen sources in Tennessee consisted of asters and goldenrod. There have not been any major losses of colonies within the State. A few beekeepers have reported individual colonies absconding upon the onset of the colder temperatures. Local honey remains at \$16.00 per pound retail for wildflower and \$24.00 per pound for Sourwood.

TEXAS: During the month of November temperatures were well above normal across most of the state. Precipitation during November was below normal across most of the state. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor website, North Texas had mostly normal soil moisture. South Texas had mostly moderate to severe drought conditions. Far West Texas had mostly exceptional drought conditions. Things are fairly quiet with most beekeepers starting to supplement feed their hives. Too few prices exist to establish a current market price for wholesale white honey.

WASHINGTON: No report issued.

WISCONSIN: November has had colder temperatures but warmed up late in the month and more than average rainfall with a small amount of snow. Beekeepers have prepared for the winter. Beekeepers report that there is no more wild foliage for their bees. Most beekeepers report no problems with insects and some have finished treatment for mites. Some beekeepers have finished feeding their bees, some others continue to feed them, and a few say that the colonies have sufficient stores of honey. Most beekeepers report that their bees are in good condition and are ready for winter. Demand for honey is good at the retail level and fairly good at the wholesale level. Prices are generally unchanged.
