The Department of Agriculture purchased canned and frozen vegetables as indicated below for distribution to the child nutrition and other related domestic food assistance programs for July 1, 2019 through September 30, 2019.

Contracts were awarded to the following companies in response to Solicitation No. 2000005429 dated July 27, 2018. All contracts are effective as of August 28, 2018. Deliveries will take place between July 1, 2019, and September 30, 2019. Award summary and contract details follow below.

Twenty-five (25) truckloads, or 40,500 cases, of Corn Cream Style Can 24/300 (material 100310) and eight-three (83) truckloads, or 134,460 cases, of Peas Can 24/300 (material 100314) cannot be awarded because no bids were submitted.
