The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) invites offers to WILD RICE, Traditionally-harvested (WRTH) for USDA/Food Distribution Programs on Indian Reservations. Wild Rice shall be stored in a freezer at temperatures not exceeding 32 degrees Fahrenheit. Wild Rice stored at an ambient temperature will not be warrantied.

QUALITY ASSURANCE:

In accordance with Wild Rice Commercial Item Description A-A-20378 (CID) and the Wild Rice Commodity Requirements Document (WR2) the quality of the Wild Rice shall be assured by testing and a Certificate of Conformance.
