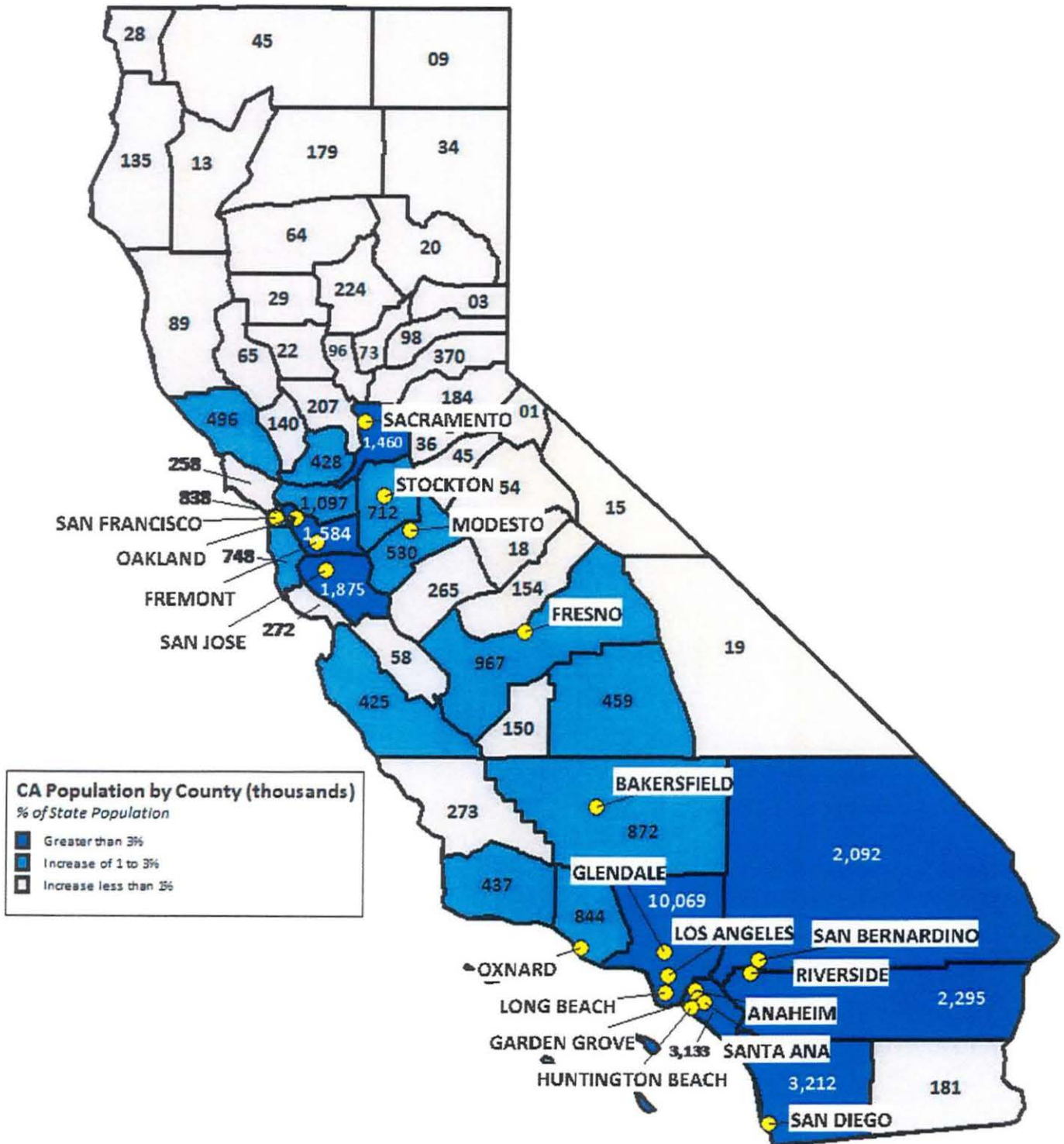

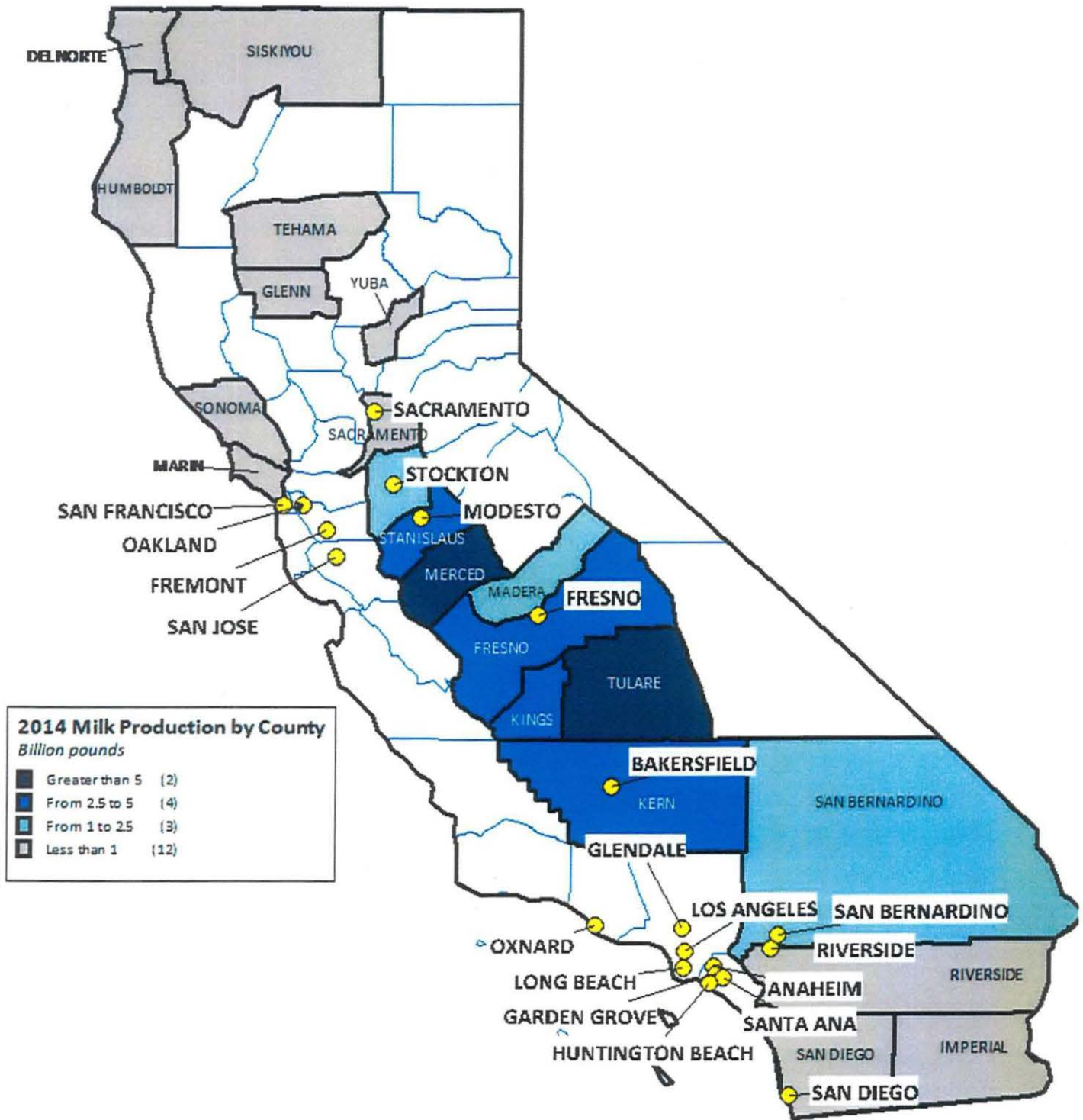

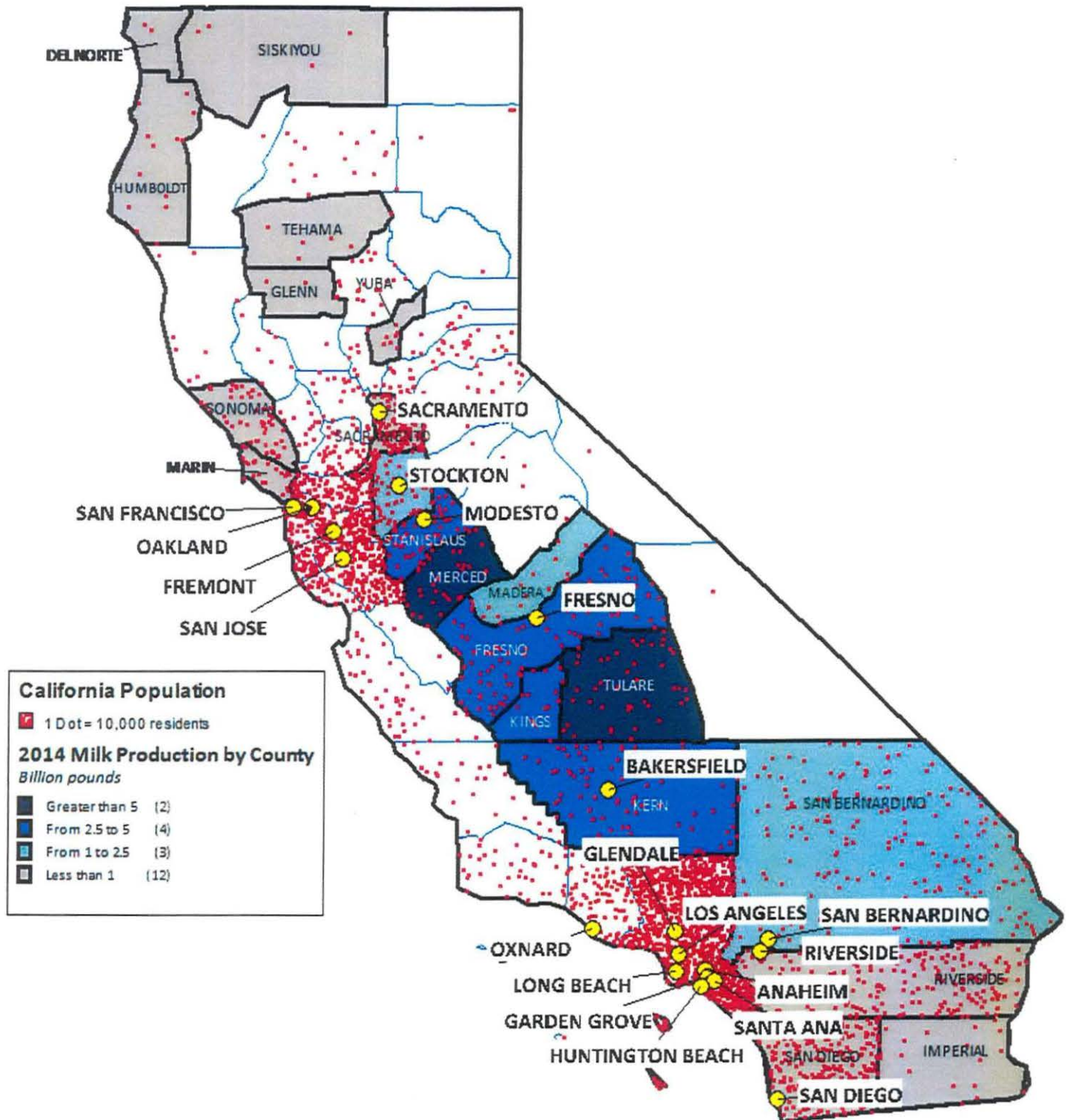
California Milk Production by County

California Milk Production & Population

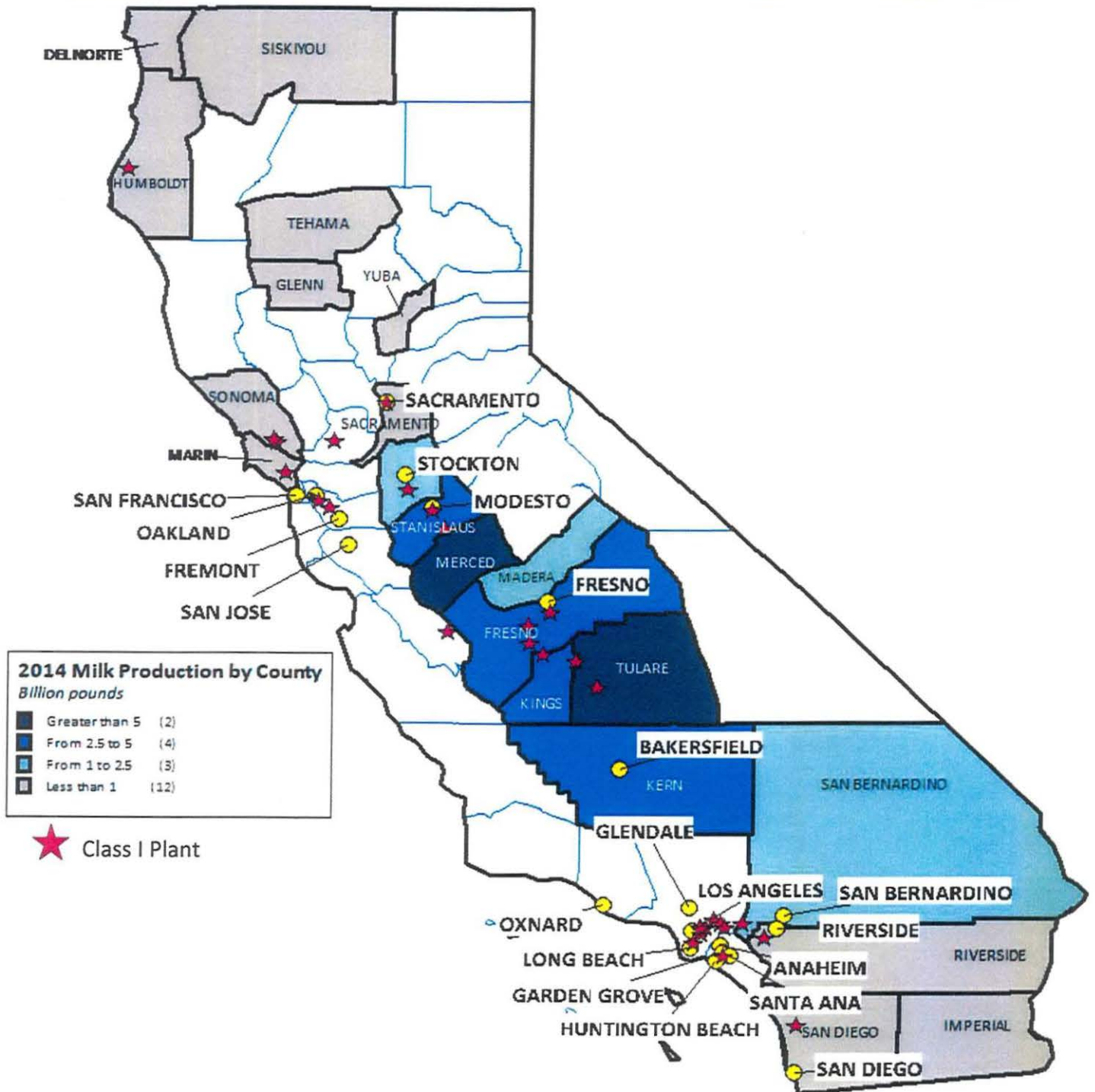

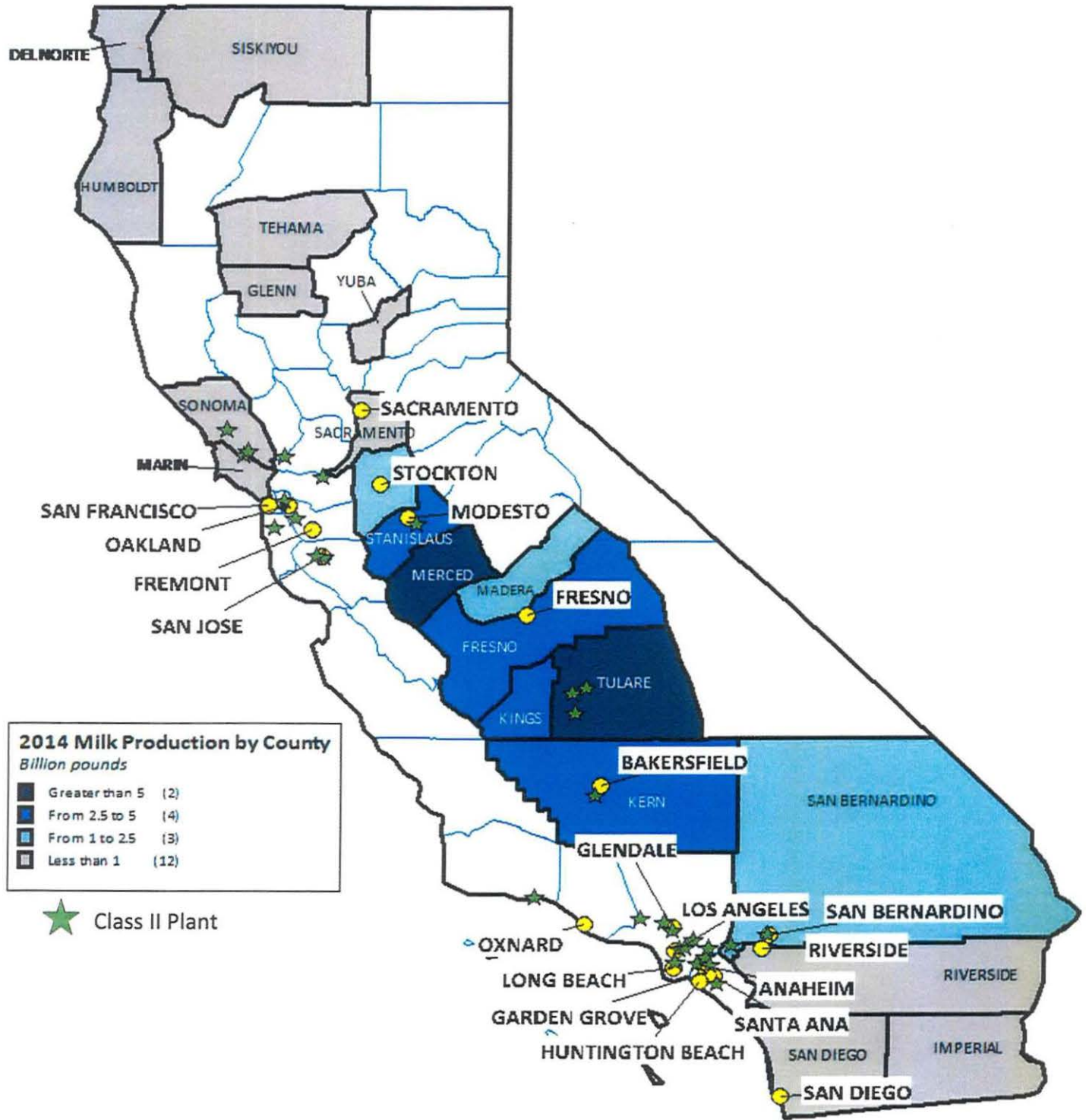
