Summary of data collection: The MA office's were asked to provide the number of plants by four types; producer-handlers, exempt, regulated pool distributing, and partially regulated distributing in 11 size ranges of total pounds of sales for each order. The sizes were: 1. less than 150,000; 2. 150,000 to less than 300,000; 3. 300,000 to less than 450,000; 4. 450,000 to less than 600,000; 5. 600,000 to less than 1 million; 6. 1 million to less than 2 million; 7. 2 million to less than 3 million; 8. 3 million to less than 5 million; 9. 5 million to less than 10 million; 10. 10 million to less than 20 million; and, 11. more than 20 million.

The MA offices were also asked to indicate the plants with own farm milk for each type of handler. The numbers were added across all orders and then in order to not disclose any one plants' operation in each type the sizes were combined if needed.
