Instructions for completing a NAQS import certificate

This certificate is issued by certification bodies (also called control body or certifying agent) in countries that have made equivalence arrangement with Korea according to the Article 25 of the 「Act on the Promotion of Environment-Friendly Agriculture and Fisheries and the Management of and Support for Organic Food」, and designated to attest that organic processed foods for exporting to Korea were produced under the equivalent requirements and standards to those of the Republic of Korea.

1. **Certifying Agent (name and address):** It is the name and complete address, including postal code, of certification body the agent that issued this NAQS import certificate.
2. **Import Certificate number:** It is a document number of NAQS import certificate, which is automatically completed by NAQS Organic Import System (NAQS OIS). It is to avoid duplicate use in other certificates, and if a NAQS import certificate is replaced it is partially changed to ensure traceability.
3. **Certified to _____ organic standard:** The name of organic standards to which the product(s) and the final manufacturer covered by this NAQS import certificate are certified. (e.g. U.S.: 7 CFR part 205, EU: Regulation (EU) 2018/848, UK: Council Regulation (EC) 834/2007 (GB), CA: Safe Food for Canadians Regulations Par 13)
4. **Exported by (name and address):** It is the name and complete address, including postal code, of the individual or business that is exporting the product(s) to Korea.
5. **First consignee in the importing country (name and address):** It is the name and complete address, including postal code, of the individual or business that is the first consignee of the product(s).
6. **Imported by (name and address):** It is the name and complete address, including postal code, of the individual or business that will receive the product(s) in Korea.
7. **Product exported from (country and port of loading):** It is the name of the port (or

airport) and the country where product(s) are loaded and leave the country.

8. **Destination (Country and port of unloading):** The name of the port (or airport) and the country (Korea, Republic of) where the product(s) are unloaded.
9. **Attestation for the terms of arrangement:** This is for product(s) covered by the NAQS import certificate. According to the related equivalence arrangement which the product(s) are covered by, the relevant attestation '**Certified in compliance with the terms of the U.S./EU/UK/CA- Korea Equivalence Arrangement**' must be entered.
10. **Name and signature of authorized person:** This person is the individual of the certifying agent who is authorized to issue the NAQS import certificate on behalf of the certifying agent. The individual is responsible for all aspects of the issuance of the NAQS import certificate.
11. **Stamp of certifying agent:** It is an official seal of the certifying agent to which the individual in box 10 belongs.
12. **Product name:** It is the name mentioned in the package or the name that importers want to label on the product for market. Multiple products may be covered by a NAQS import certificate, but must be entered separately.
13. **Certification Number:** This is a unique identification number for certified final manufacturer in box 14, which is assigned when operators are certified under the organic regulations. This number is a part of labeling requirements, and should be indicated in package of organic products sold in Korea. In case where multiple products and different final manufacturers are covered by this NAQS import certificate, each certification number must be entered. Certification number system may be different per trading partners:
 - Korea-U.S. equivalence arrangement: NOP ID under the Korea-U.S. equivalence arrangement
 - Korea-EU equivalence arrangement: ISO country code – a serial number of operators

(through TRACES)

- Korea-UK equivalence arrangement: CB code – operator code assigned by control bodies
- Korea-CA equivalence arrangement: a serial code assigned by control bodies

14. **Final Manufacturer (Name and Address):** It is the name and complete address, including postal code, of individual or business that produces the final exporting product. In case of multiple products, each final manufacturer of products must be indicated.
15. **Certifying Agent of Final Manufacturer:** The certifying agent which certifies the final manufacturer and final exporting product. It must include the name and complete address, including postal code, of the certifying agent.
16. **HS code:** Enter first 6-digit HS code of the product(s) in box 12.
17. **Net weight:** The total net weight of the product, based on kilogram (kg). In case where multiple products are covered by this NAQS import certificate, the weights must be separately entered.
18. **Bol No.:** Box 18 must be B/L No.
