Livestock Mandatory Reporting Live Lamb & Lamb Meat Reporting

LMR Lamb

- Packers that slaughter 35,000 head per year are required to report or import 1,000 or more metric tons.
- Currently 6 sheep plants and 18 lamb plants (includes importers) are covered.
- LMR covers 59% of all slaughter sheep transactions and 50% of boxed lamb transactions.

LMR Staff and Data

- One reporter covers sheep and lamb
- Process around 2,000 records per day
- Importing, reviewing, analyzing, verifying data
- Generate, edit and publish three daily and five weekly reports

Purchase Types

- **Negotiated:** Cash or spot market purchase of sheep by a packer from a producer under which the price is determined by buyer-seller interaction and agreement on delivery terms. This is a flat price that does not change and is not dependent upon any other conditions.
- **Formula Marketing Arrangement:** The advance commitment of lambs for slaughter using a method or calculation to determine the price in which the price is frequently determined at a future date.
- **Packer Owned:** Lambs that a packer owns for at least 28 days immediately before slaughter.

Sales Types

Negotiated: This is a sale by a packer selling boxed lamb to a buyer of boxed lamb, under which the price is determined by seller-buyer interaction and agreement, and scheduled for delivery not later than 14 days.

Formula Sale: The advance commitment of boxed lamb by any means other than through a negotiated purchase or forward contract, using a method for calculating price in which the price is determined at a future date.

Forward Sale: The agreement for the sale of boxed lamb, executed in advance of manufacture, under which the base price is established by reference to publicly available quoted prices.

- Boxed Lamb Reports: 3/70/20 is applied to the boxed lamb reports as a whole over a 60 day period.

Data Review

- Reporter reviews submitted files at submission deadlines. Use a checklist to ensure all expected plants have reported and then import data files.
- Reporter looks for any invalid records, contacts plant, and corrects data.
- Reporters identify data outliers and call the plant to inquire about lots in question before generating reports.
