John Ben Carroll submits the following modifications on behalf of New England Producer-Handlers Association, Inc., et al.:

1. In all orders, and/or orders #1 and #5, the producer-handler exemption should be expanded to apply to the Class I sales of handlers who operate, in common, a milk production facility and the processing and packaging facility used to process and package the raw milk from the aforementioned milk production facility
 - a. In all orders, and/or #1 and #5, the expanded producer-handler exemption detailed in paragraph (1) shall apply for those entities with Class I sales up to 3,000,000 pounds per month. Any Class I sales above 3,000,000 pounds per month will be subject to the pricing and pooling provisions of the order.
2. In all orders, the exempt plant provision limit should be increased to include up to 3,000,000 pounds per month of Class I route disposition and packages sales of fluid milk products. Any Class I sales above 3,000,000 pounds per month will be subject to the pricing and pooling provisions of the order.
