## Summary of Opinion:

- Aloe Vera is a useful tool for organic livestock production unfortunately it seems not to be available
  without preservatives of which it's is the length insurance at a region.
- Independent of the Processing decision the Loveston of Communication compelled to go on record endorsing KS for this specific use.
